Dear parents/carers,

After a successful phonics evening in previous years, we have decided to deliver another, particularly for Dexter Class and for the current Y1 parents, whose children will be taking part in the Phonics Screening assessment in June 2022.

Our phonics evening will be on Wednesday 29th September 2021 from 5.30pm, in the hall.

Phonics is incredibly important and teaches children to both read and write. At the end of year 1, children sit a statutory phonic screening test. This looks at children's reading and assesses their knowledge of all the sounds taught in all phases.

The aim of this evening is to share the terminology and expectations with parents so that they are able to successfully to support their children at home. It will guide parents and carers through the phonic expectations from EYFS to up to Y1, and will also provide examples of past phonic papers, websites, resources and ideas to support with the teaching of phonics at home.

I am the English Lead in school with Mrs Stevens leading phonics. We will share the requirements as well as answering any questions regarding the Y1 phonics screening. Mrs Penn and Mrs Crampton will be there to support the teaching of phonics in Dexter Class.

We would love to see as many parents as possible at this evening, it is not just for Reception and Y1 parents but would also support spelling in Year 2 and lower KS2.
