We intend to start with a spelling, punctuation, vocabulary and grammar session on 15th November, 6:30pm - 8pm in the year 6 classroom.

In light of the new national curriculum, introduced in 2014, spelling, punctuation, vocabulary and grammar has increased in priority. At the end of both key stages, children will sit two SATS paper, which will test them on the statutory requirements taught in school.

The aim of this evening is to share the expectations with parents so that they are able to continue to support their children at home. This evening will guide parents and carers through the national curriculum expectations right from reception to year 6, and will also provide examples of past SATS papers.

I have attached the progression of SPVG throughout the school for your information. I am sure you will agree that this evening will help many of you, as there are some challenging concepts that children have to get to grips with!
